Compared to last sale (1-17-25): The last Friday feeder special was in the middle of January. All comparisons are to last months feeder special. Feeder steer calves sold 8.00-12.00 higher on all classes. Heifer calves under 550 lbs sold mostly 10.00 higher in a narrow comparison. Heifers over 550 lbs sold mostly 15.00-20.00 higher, with instances of as much as 25.00 higher seen on attractive offerings. Demand for all feeder cattle was good to very good. Offerings were moderate. Feeder quality was mixed from plain to very attractive this sale. Most calves were weaned over 60 days with some offerings weaned over 100 days. Demand for all calves to go to grass remains good to very good. Package sizes were mixed today, however buyers showed good demand for all calves on offer. Demand remained constant throughout the sale which stretched well into the afternoon. A moderate size buyer pool was on hand for todays sale and buyers bid rapidly on feeders as they pushed to fill loads. Demand for heifers was very good today especially on heifers over 650 lbs. Several packages of attractive heifers were purchased to make replacements and feeding buyers and replacement buyers both showed good demand for this weight of heifers. Market activity was mostly active today with bidders both ringside as well as over the internet actively bidding on offerings. Weigh up cows and bulls were too lightly tested to develop any market trend. Demand was mostly light for very light offerings. Weigh up conditions were mostly below average as many cows were very full. Cow quality today was mostly average. Slaughter bulls sold on mostly moderate demand. Supply included: 98% Feeder Cattle (46% Steers, 53% Heifers, 1% Bulls); 1% Slaughter Cattle (84% Cows, 16% Bulls); 1% Replacement Cattle (95% Stock Cows, 5% Bred Cows). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 61%.
