Compared to last week: Feeder Steers sold 3.00 higher. Not enough comparable sales on heifers for an adequate market trend. Drought like conditions continue to plague the region. As a result, the majority of pastures are in fair to very poor condition. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (80.6% Steers, 19.4% Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 97%. Unless otherwise noted, Feeder Cattle prices FOB based on net weights after a 3% shrink or equivalent, with a 5-12 cent slide > 600 lbs. and 9-15 cent slide < 600 lbs. Livestock reported this week originated from NM.
