Compared to last week: Not enough comparable sales on feeder steers or heifers for a market trend. Drought conditions persist across the majority of the state. Recently planted winter wheat is in desperate need of a rain in order for the crop to emerge. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (47.1% Steers, 52.9% Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 93%. Unless otherwise noted, Feeder Cattle prices FOB based on net weights after a 0% shrink or equivalent, with a 0 cent slide > 600 lbs. and 0 cent slide < 600 lbs. Livestock reported this week originated from NM.
