Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers not well tested for Current FOB trade. Winter weather in many areas of the country making it difficult to move cattle. Demand moderate. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (66.2% Steers, 33.8% Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 72%. Unless otherwise noted, Feeder Cattle prices FOB based on net weights after a 2-3% shrink or equivalent, with a 4-8 cent slide > 600 lbs. and 8-12 cent slide < 600 lbs. Livestock reported this week originated from NM.
