Compared to last week: Not enough comparable sales on domestic origin feeder steers or heifers for a market trend. Mexican origin heifers were 1.00 to 2.00 higher. Not enough comparable sales on Mexican origin steers for a trend. Trading activity and demand were moderate. Despite some scattered showers in the region, 99.99% of the state is still in some drought category. This is compared to only 32% a year ago. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (30.1% Steers, 69.9% Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 30%. Unless otherwise noted, Feeder Cattle prices FOB based on net weights after a 2-3% shrink or equivalent, with a 4-8 cent slide > 600 lbs. and 8-12 cent slide < 600 lbs. Livestock reported this week originated from NM.
