Compared to last week: Not enough comparable sales on domestic origin cattle for a market trend. Mexican Origin steers traded mostly steady. Trading activity was moderate on moderate demand. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (90.4% Steers, 9.6% Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 26%. Unless otherwise noted, Feeder Cattle prices FOB based on net weights after a 2 -3% shrink or equivalent, with a 6-8 cent slide > 600 lbs. Livestock reported this week originated from NM.
