Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers traded mostly 2.00 higher. Trading activity was moderate on moderate demand. Drought conditions continue to expand across the state due to lack of moisture and extreme winds Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (65.5% Steers, 34.5% Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 40%. Unless otherwise noted, Feeder Cattle prices FOB based on net weights after a 2 -3% shrink or equivalent, with a 6-8 cent slide > 600 lbs. Livestock reported this week originated from NM.
