Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers traded mostly 5.00 higher. Trading activity was moderate to active on good buyer demand. Portions of the trading region received some much needed rain, which increased demand. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (87.9% Steers, 12.1% Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 100%. Unless otherwise noted, Feeder Cattle prices FOB based on net weights after a 2-3 % shrink or equivalent, with a 4-8 cent slide > 600 lbs. Livestock reported this week originated from NM.
