Compared to last week: The light test of hay traded sold mostly steady. Hay movement remained slow with mixed demand. Many producers reported light precipitation over the past week. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor 88.93% of the state is in moderate drought or worse; 85.91% of the state is in an severe drought or worse, 48.86% of the state is in an extreme drought or worse; 5.64% of the state is in an exceptional drought.
