Compared to last week: The light test of hay sold steady. Tight supply, slow movement and good demand continue throughout the state. Light scattered moisture reported over the past week, though much of the state remains in drought. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor, 87.17% of the state is in Moderate drought or worse, 84.94% of the state is in an Severe drought or worse, 51.86% of the state is in Extreme drought or worse, and 0% of the state is in Exceptional drought, a 3.89% decrease from last week. The next report will be Friday, March 25, 2022.
