Compared to last week: The special fed veal carcass market was lower on comparable sales of veal calves. Demand was light to moderate on light to moderate offerings. Harvest numbers were 1 percent lower compared to last week's total. Dressed weights were up 7.8 pounds.

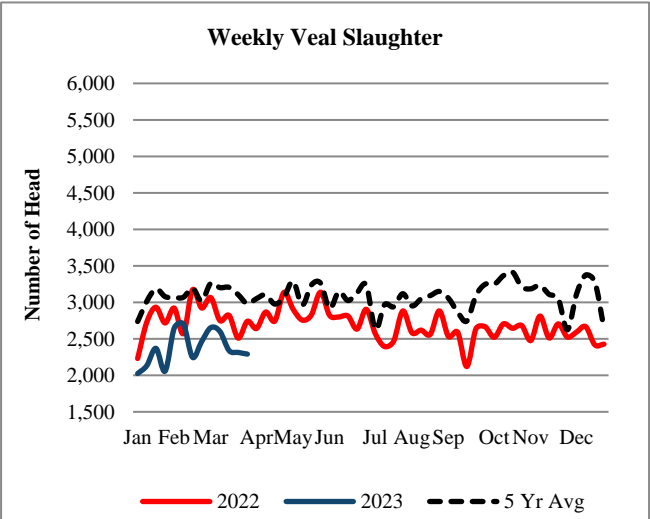
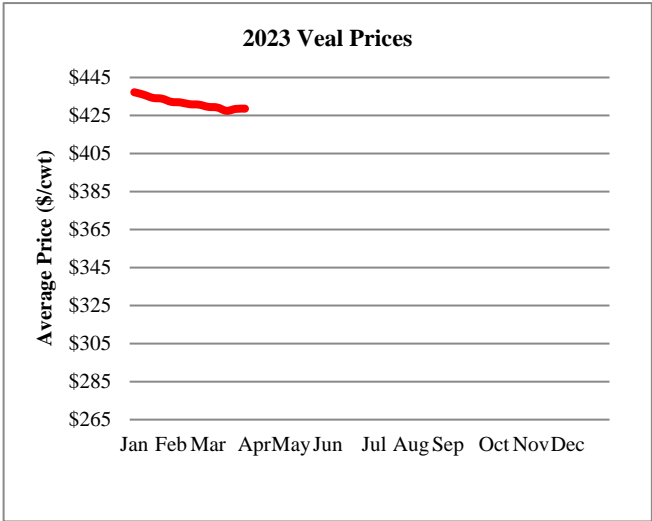
