Northeast and North Central Basis - 3/26/2023 - 4/1/2023
Compared to last week: The special fed veal carcass market was lower on comparable sales of veal calves. Demand was light to moderate on light to moderate offerings. Harvest numbers were 8.2 percent higher compared to last week's total. Dressed weights were up 1.4 pounds.

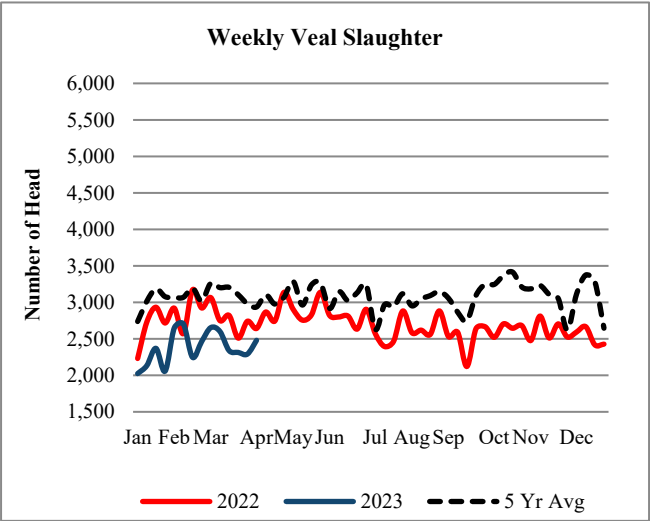
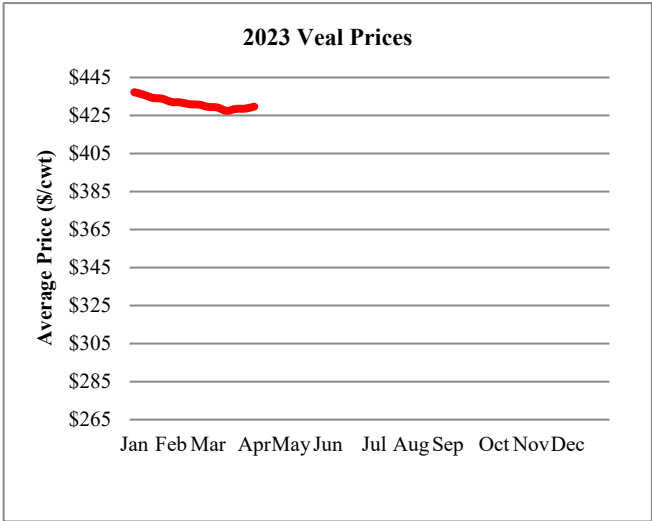
