New York prices are 10 cents lower for Extra Large, Large, and Medium. California and regional prices are 31 cents lower for Jumbo, down 17 to 36 cents for Extra Large, 12 to 40.5 cents lower for Large, 12 to 32 cents lower for Medium, and down 18 cents for Small. The undertone is weak. Demand is light to moderate with instances fairly good in the retail channels. Offerings are light to moderate. Supplies are generally moderate. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock offerings are light for the light to occasionally fairly good demand. Light type fowl supplies are light; processing schedules are normal to less than normal.

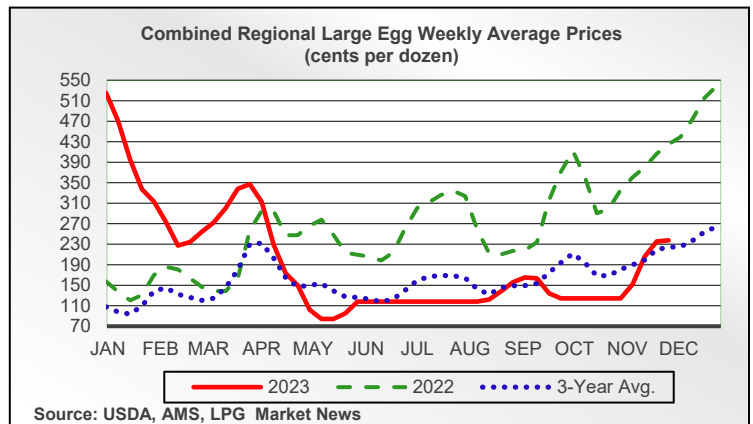
