## COLONY, HONEY PLANT AND MARKET CONDITIONS DURING APRIL 2022

APPALACHIAN DISTRICT (MD, PA, VA, WV): April would warm up for a few days, cool down for a few days, warm again, cool again, and follow this pattern for the entire month. Mid-month saw several days of freezing evening temperatures. Several scattered and isolated showers were present and overcast, breezy days. Colonies were active and gathering nectar and pollen from various spring ephemerals, maples, orchards and other spring blooming trees and floral sources. Brood rearing was quite active, yet several beekeepers reported queen failures, some dead colonies, and at the end of the month a lot of swarming.

ALABAMA: Low rainfall in much of the state potentially slowed colony growth due to reduced nectar and pollen production. Regardless, swarming by colonies and swarm management by beekeepers occurred throughout the state for the entire month. Some beekeepers received their first packages of the year during April, and most with over-wintered colonies supered them sometime during the month. Many plant species were in bloom, including holly, clover, tulip poplar, tupelo, doghobble, brambles, and privet. Most beekeeping clubs met in person.

ARIZONA: Severe dryness continued for more than half of Arizona for the month of April, limiting forage availability for the state's bees. High winds in the southeastern part of the state also affected forage and soil. Across the state, pasture and range conditions were rated mostly poor to very poor. Farmers also began to plant corn crops, which may provide bees with additional pollen. Little rain was reported for the entire state. Most of the state's cotton crop has already been planted.

ARKANSAS: During the month of April temperatures were above normal across most of the state. Precipitation during April was below normal across most of the same area. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, Arkansas had normal soil moisture across the Northern part of the state with an area of abnormally dry conditions across the central and southern part of the state for April.

No supply chain issues reported. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

CALIFORNIA: "April saw cool weather which curtailed the sage honey production that we were enjoying," a California beekeepers said. "The sage plants kept progressing and are now dried up. It looked like we were going to have some good sage to sell, but it was severely curtailed." Bees were also put to work pollinating vegetable seed, but that was stymied by cool weather. "Such is farming!" a beekeeper said.

Colonies continued to rebuild, and beekeepers made divides "as we were able to get mated queens rather easily except for a 10-day delay due to cold weather the first few weeks of April, which hampered queen mating flights." Honey prices should remain stable or increase due to the lack of production, beekeeper said.

FLORIDA: Temperatures and precipitation were about average for the month. Bee health was considered to be fairly good. Some bees were pollinating watermelons in Central Florida during April. The cold and windy weather in March did cause the orange blossom honey yield to be very low this year. Titi finished blooming early in the month. Tupelo began blooming around the middle of the month. Tupelo honey production was expected to be a little better than last year. Moisture levels were a little higher this year and seemed to contribute to more honey production. Some tupelo honey was pulled before the end of the month, but most of the tupelo honey is expected to be pulled in early May. Gallberry and palmetto also were both available before the end of the month. There were light supplies of tupelo honey stored at the end of the month with slightly larger supplies of stored Gallberry honey. Demand was very good for tupelo and good for Gallberry honey.

GEORGIA: April had good days and terrible days. Plenty of cold wet weather coupled with some nice warm dry days. Beekeepers are hoping for a good Sourwood crop and the rain stays away for a little while. Watermelon is about finished and Gallberry, wildflowers, and berries are still available. Plenty of wildflowers are coming along and some beekeepers are getting ready to check and pull honey if it looks good color wise. Commercial purchases are starting to come in a little better and beekeepers are holding meetings and sales in public once again. Transportation is hard to find for large shipments making costs go even higher than expected at times. Tupelo looks good.

IDAHO, COLORADO, UTAH: During the month of April temperatures were slightly below normal across all Western and Eastern Idaho. Utah had temperatures that were normal across the entire state. Colorado had temperatures that were normal across the entire state. Precipitation during April was incredibly below average for Utah, Precipitation was just a little below normal for western Idaho, eastern Idaho saw above average precipitation. Western Colorado saw precipitation that was below normal. Eastern Colorado saw precipitation that was far below normal for April.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in April Idaho had no dry soil to extreme drought soil with most of the state under moderate to severe drought. Utah is currently under Severe to extreme drought conditions. The whole state of Colorado is between Moderate dry to severe drought with a couple patches of extreme dry soil.

Demand for Locally sourced honey has been good throughout all three states, Producers are keeping up with the demand for local honey in all three states. Most producers are in the middle of or just finishing up splitting hives and waiting for more plants to bloom.

Prices for the month of April were between \$2.35 and \$3.50 per pound with a mostly price of \$2.40-\$3.00 for Idaho, Colorado prices are \$2.30-\$2.70 per pound for local honey. Prices for locally sourced honey in Utah are average \$2.50-\$3.00 per pound with mostly \$2.27-\$2.36.

ILLINOIS: Temperatures for the month of April were generally cold and damp with precipitation being above normal for this time of year. This is causing production to run later this year and has some beekeepers worrying some of their colonies will not be strong enough the year. Beekeepers report some problems with mites that have caused damage and killed some bees. Some Beekeepers have restocked from California. Most bees, including new stock are homebound mostly due to weather. Beekeepers report the following foliage in bloom: Early Willows and Soft and Hard Maple with Dandelions beginning. Demand for honey is very good at retail and wholesale levels. Prices are generally unchanged.

INDIANA: Temperatures for the month of April were slightly cooler than average for the month with rainfall in most parts of the states average for this time of the year. Beekeepers report that maple and willow are in bloom. Most beekeepers report their bees are in good condition, while some are rebuilding. Demand for honey was good at the retail level and wholesale levels. Prices are generally unchanged.

IOWA, KANSAS, MISSOURI, NEBRASKA: No report issued.

**KENTUCKY:** Kentucky beekeepers experienced much colder temperatures in April 2022 than in years past. Snow, hail, late season frosts were hallmarks of the first two weeks of the month. These lower-than-expected temperatures meant that hives, consequently, were delayed in swarms and honey production. Swarm season seemed to get started approximately April 15-17th, and by the time the month ended, the entire state had posted swarm reports. The nectar flow seemed to start approximately the third week of April and by the time the month ended, hives were bringing in nectar and pollen in abundance.

The Kentucky State Beekeepers Association held its first in-person spring meeting and had a good turn-out. The Kentucky Queen Bee Producers have placed an order for Hilo Queens for its members in an effort to get more varroa tolerant strains in the state. Some bee associations had scheduled field events, and fortunately, the weather cooperated.

The bee supply vendors have been able to substitute different varieties of lumber for their woodenware, swapping out cypress for pine for instance. But prices for woodenware are higher than years past as are prices for other supplies, such as the corrugated nuc boxes that a staple of spring.

**LOUISIANA:** During the month of April temperatures were above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was below normal to well below normal across the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, Louisiana was abnormally dry across most of the state with an area of extremely dry conditions across the Southern part of the state for April.

No supply chain issues reported. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

**MICHIGAN:** No report issued.

**MINNESOTA:** During the month of April temperatures were a little below normal across the entire state. Precipitation in April was far above average for the North end of the state and precipitation was above normal for the south end of the state of Minnesota.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in April northern Minnesota had no dry soil and the southern part of Minnesota has no drought soil to abnormally dry soil conditions.

Supply for Minnesota honey is starting to look slightly short this year for locally sourced honey, but producers seem to be keeping up with the demand, most producers are finishing up bringing their hives back from California and Texas.

Prices per pound in Minnesota were \$2.25-\$5.00 with mostly price of \$2.80-\$3.75 for locally sourced honey for the month of April.

**MISSISSIPPI:** Beekeepers are busy placing nucs and splitting supers for sale and to replace lost hives during the cold winter months. Clover and wildflowers are available when the rain is not pouring down and keeping the bees inside the hives. Heavy winds, rain and cold temps made it rough on the bees early in the month and they appear to be getting back into shape and searching for food.

**MONTANA:** No report issued.

**NEW ENGLAND:** No report issued.

**NEW YORK:** April 2022 in New York had cooler weather prevail with about a 10 day bloom delay for plants such as dandelion. Soils were saturated in most areas. Hives brooding up well but requiring extra feed. Many beekeepers splitting hives. Average winter survival statewide was better than recent years with losses ~26%, but some areas reporting significant loss, perhaps due to the boom of early summer 2021 and bust of the late summer/fall of the honey crop in impacted regions. Migratory pollination operations moving in place for the fruit bloom at the end of the month. Honey demand and prices remain strong.

**NORTH CAROLINA:** Temperatures in North Carolina were quite variable in April with a statewide average temperature of 58.8°F; precipitation was below normal, again. Overall statewide soil moisture levels were rated 6 percent very short, 25 percent short, 68 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus the week ending April 30. The North Carolina Drought Management Advisory Council reported 12 counties as being abnormally dry, 18 counties as experiencing moderate drought conditions, and 10 counties as experiencing severe drought conditions.

The nectar flow got underway in April, however, a stretch of extreme lows left concern for damage to nectar producing plants. Sumac became an available nectar source across the State. In the Piedmont region Dandelion, Clover (Alsike, Crimson, and Ladino white clover), Blackberry, Tulip Poplar, Black Gum, Black Locust, Vetch, Holly (including Gallberry), and Raspberry began to bloom around mid to late April. Dandelion, Blackberry, Tulip Poplar, Black Gum, Holly, Raspberry, Huckleberry, and Tupelo Gum began blooming in the Coastal Plains region. As a result, bees were able to buildup populations and reports of swarming continued in the southeastern region of the state, according to apiary inspectors.

Commercial pollinator hives were back in North Carolina. Strawberry pollination was active in early April; then hives progressed into blueberries; and by the end of the month began preparing to move up the East Coast to New Jersey, and later Maine, for blueberry and cranberry pollination. Others were preparing hives to move into local cucurbit fields; however, it was noted that some producers were not planting summer vegetables this season due to the rising inputs costs and therefore pollination services were not necessary. Some commercial beekeepers were moving hives to areas for honey production.

Retail honey prices at the Raleigh State Farmers' Market were generally unchanged: \$7.00-\$8.00 per 8-ounce jar, \$12.00-\$13.00 per 16-ounce jar, \$20.00-\$22.00 per 32-ounce jar, and \$18.00 per 44-ounce jar; processed honey, creamed, was \$10.00 per 16-ounce jar. Prices at the Piedmont Triad Farmers' Market in Greensboro were also unchanged at: \$8.00-\$12.00 per 8-ounce jar, \$12.00-\$18.00 per 22-ounce jar, and \$20.00 per 32-ounce jar.

**NORTH & SOUTH DAKOTA:** Topsoil and subsoil moisture continues to be very short to mostly short or adequate. Early Spring plantings and emergence were well behind last year, but generally in line with the average. Some bees relocated to the Pacific Northwest faced adverse weather conditions, with rain, snow, freezing temperatures and strong winds.

**OHIO:** Northwest Ohio: Overwintered bees are building up despite the weather. April has been cloudy and cool with bouts of warm weather. Sunny warm days also bring strong winds. Some swarming has started, May will bring lots of swarms. A lot of colonies are eating hand to mouth as all nectar and pollen that is gathered on nice days are being used to raise brood. Fruit trees are starting to bloom, dandelions, dead nettles, and red bud are blooming. Honey prices are \$5.50 to \$6.50 per pound wholesale and \$8.50 to \$10.50 per pound retail.

Southeast Ohio: The bees are building up strong with the delay of planting in the fields other plants like Dead Nettle are blooming like crazy. The weather is delaying the swarm season, but we are now in to it in central Ohio. The swarm season should be Hugh. In order to prevent colonies from swarming look for queen cells during inspection and make splits to expand your operation.

West Central Ohio: April has been rainy, a few very warm days, many cool days, cloudy and windy. Farmers will be delayed in planting crops this year which will allow bees and other pollinators access to many types of weeds to obtain pollen and nectar for spring build up. As soon as there are a few warm days swarming season will began. From both managed colonies and feral colonies. Commercial bee Colony losses this year are over 70%. Locally Adapted Bee losses are about 25 %. The Ohio Queen bee Improvement Project. LLC swarm trapping network will have several hundred traps set to catch feral honeybees.

Cool temperatures and plentiful amounts of rainfall should provide a bounty of May flowers, although it has delayed the bloom of dependable nectar and pollen sources, keeping pollinators under cover. In general, they have only been able to fly one day a week with a few exceptions. In the third week of April, temperatures from northern Ohio to the southwest corner averaged in the fifties, then the weekend peaked in the seventies or low eighties, followed by more fifty and forty degree temperatures.

Growing degree days were slow to accumulate as well. In Cincinnati the GGD ranged from 169 with the saucer magnolia in bloom to 313 when the Sargent crabapple began to flower. Columbus followed a similar pattern with the GDD at 125 with the Sargent crabapple flowering then 263 when the Eastern redbud showed its lavender color. In the Toledo area, the GDD was 77 on April 1, then rose to 187 with the lovely scent of the Koreanspice viburnum filling the air.

On the warm weekend, the growers were finally able to plant, and the honeybees made up for lost time. Swarm calls have begun, mostly from beekeepers whose strong colonies survived the winter and have grown with continual feeding. Nuc producers have been unable to produce splits for sale. Many colonies are woefully behind. A few more warm days should enable most colonies to expand.

OKLAHOMA: During the month of April temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was well below normal across the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, East to West, soil conditions of normal to extreme drought conditions progressed across the state.

OREGON: No report issued.

SOUTH CAROLINA: No report issued.

TENNESSEE: Honey sales are pretty much back to normal since the Pandemic. Supply chain and inflation have been major negative impacts on the beekeeping industry. Tennessee has been experiencing a very heavy nectar flow this spring. Black locust, clover, redbud were the major nectar plants in April. Overall, the colonies across the state are building up rapidly and putting up large quantities of honey.

TEXAS: During the month of April temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation during April was well below normal. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, soil moisture conditions for April showed soil moisture conditions from severe drought to areas of extreme drought across most of the state. Overall, April was extremely dry compared to an average April in Texas.

April saw a widespread in temperatures across the state. Add in the dry conditions and the wildflowers that are normally so beautiful this time of year never had a real chance. A few showers scattered around the state had things starting to green up but that was only select areas and only temporary.

Truck availability has become less of an issue if you can afford the prices. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

WASHINGTON: Winter returned to much of the state in April as temperatures dropped, snow fell, and the wind blew. Sub-freezing temperatures in Yakima County forced growers to utilize various frost protection systems. In many areas the bee activity was extremely limited due to the weather extremes causing doubts about pollination. The crops and areas in bloom during the first half of the month were most heavily affected and will likely see some productions shortages. Later in the month the temperatures rose some, but cold weather delayed or threatened many crops.

WISCONSIN: Temperatures for the month of April were generally cool and cloudy with lots of rainfall and misting, with less sun than other years. No problems with insects. Beekeepers report some to many hives are alive and appear to be active. Beekeepers report wild foliage for their bees which includes Snow drops, Winter Aconite, Crocus, Forsythia, Squill, Daffodils. Some beekeepers report putting sugar candy on surviving hives because it was too cold for syrup. When syrup is applied, the bees have not taken much of it. Demand was good at retail and wholesale levels. Prices are generally unchanged.
