## COLONY, HONEY PLANT AND MARKET CONDITIONS DURING NOVEMBER 2022

APPALACHIAN DISTRICT (MD, PA, VA, WV): November was a month full of roller coaster like temperature changes from above normal warm days to the first hard freeze of the year and all stops between. Precipitation was about normal with the Appalachian District receiving plenty of rainfall and the first light snow in the higher elevations. The hard freeze eliminated any fall foraging sources so Beekeepers continued to provide supplemental food for colonies as they prepared their colonies for the winter. In addition, Beekeepers attended a few local meetings, attended to equipment maintenance, and prepared sugar patties. Prices for wildflower and clover honey cartons 12 1-pound containers at the Jessup wholesale market were higher at \$85.00 per case.

ALABAMA: Much of Alabama experienced abnormally dry or even moderate drought conditions for the month of November, as well as seasonally warm temperatures. Plants such as Bidens and Camellias bloomed in southern regions of the state, whereas dandelions, henbit, and some late asters bloomed in more northern regions. Some beekeepers consolidated their colonies as they made final preparations for winter, and all beekeepers monitored for food. Colonies continued to produce brood, likely due to the warm conditions.

ARIZONA: No report issued

ARKANSAS: During the month of November temperatures were about normal across most of the state. Precipitation during was about normal for most of the same area. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, Arkansas had mostly moderate drought with an area of severe drought in the northeast corner stretching southwest across the state. No supply chain issues reported. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

CALIFORNIA: Drought throughout much of November limited forage for California bees, and cold weather cut back on flight time. However, rain and snow that began toward the end of the month in the central part of the state should improve forage prospects for late winter and early spring.

Some wildflowers have already begun to grow and could bloom by early January. Many hives have settled successfully into winter. "We just hope these storms continue off and on through our 'rainy' season!" a beekeeper said. For now, bees are being fed syrup and/or protein supplements as needed to be as healthy as possible for the upcoming almond pollination in mid-February, he said.

Some beekeepers plan to add further pollen substitutes after Christmas as the days begin to lengthen and queens begin to fire up, a beekeeper said.

Water shortages should continue to reduce almond acreage in California, which in turn should lead to lower pollination fees for the crop. Early blooming cherries and plums will also require pollination around the same time in the state, "but their acreage is so small that it is insignificant compared to the 1.3 million acres of bearing almonds which require bee pollination," a beekeeper said. Other crops benefiting from the bees ahead include California prunes and blueberries, as well as Northwest apples.

Could lower almond pollination fees reduce the number of hives brought in from out of state this winter? Several factors could influence that, including higher costs for diesel to transport hives. Plus, as honey prices increase, almond pollination could become a less attractive option. "But colony losses in Florida, and reports of losses due to varroa may balance out supply and demand," a beekeeper said. "It's all just guesses at this time." (Tom Lister)

FLORIDA: Temperatures and precipitation were about average for the month with a few cooler than average days from time to time. Bee health was considered to be below average in most areas of the state primarily because of a general lack of natural food sources. Spanish Needle and a few wildflowers were about the only source of nutrition in most of the state. Even though some Brazilian Pepper still was blooming in November, the stress the plants had undergone from the two earlier storms resulted in very little nectar being produced by the blooms. Supplemental feeding was necessary for most beekeepers, and many were heavily feeding their bees in preparation for Florida and Georgia blueberry pollination and almond pollination in California early next year. An informal poll of commercial beekeepers taken by several non-profit organizations around the Fort Myers area confirmed around 37,000 hives destroyed by Hurricane Ian. The estimated percentage of beekeepers polled in the area is unclear. An earlier estimate of 400,000 hives located within the storm's path from Fort Myers to Saint Augustine and affected by the storm appears to be fairly accurate. How many hives were actually damaged or destroyed whether in the path or elsewhere in the state, is not known at this time. Due to flooding, many hives were not accessible for days or even weeks until after the storm. Some equipment was damaged or destroyed due to prolonged exposure to water. Small hive beetles also moved into some of the untended hives, destroyed them, and created a potential infestation risk for a large area in Florida. Other untended hives were destroyed by stronger "robber bees" who caused the weaker hive to collapse due to lack of nourishment. Some hives were relocated from New York and other northern states to overwinter in Florida. Land development in Florida is shrinking the amount of land available for this purpose each year because of potential problems with interactions between bees and humans. Orange blossom honey is expected to be the next significant honey produced in the state. That season normally starts in early to mid-February. A few beekeepers reported higher priced sales of honey between \$2.85-\$3.40 depending upon grade and color of the honey. Stored supplies of honey were light at the end of the month with good demand.

GEORGIA: Sales are on the slow side but sales are still going on. Some honey producers do not have a lot of reserve for later in the year. The bees are reported to be strong and in good condition with most feeding off of pollen patties and nurse mated for winter. There were a few cold nights and freeze warnings around the state but no real threat to the bees as the temps went back up and with little sporadic rain the bees have taken advantage of the weather and are still producing brood to be split later. Prices reported: Wildflower \$3.50 lb, Tupelo \$6.50 lb, Sourwood \$6.50 lb.

IDAHO, COLORADO, UTAH: During the month of November temperatures were well below normal across Idaho, Utah, and Colorado. Precipitation for November was average for Idaho, Utah, and Colorado.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in November Idaho had very little relief from the dry situation. It had moderate drought to an area of severe drought along the southern border. Utah is currently under severe to extreme drought conditions with most of the state under extremely dry soil conditions. Colorado has an area of normal soil moisture through the center of the state with areas of moderate to severe drought in the eastern and western portions of the state.

Prices for the month of November were between \$2.60 and \$3.20 per pound with a mostly price of \$2.80-\$3.00 for Idaho, Colorado prices are too few producers reporting to determine a market. Prices for locally sourced honey in Utah are \$2.80-\$3.00 per pound with mostly \$2.80.

ILLINOIS: The weather for November has been slightly warmer than average, with less than normal rainfall. Few beekeepers continued supplemental feeding of their bees. No foliage remains. The bees are ready for winter. Demand for honey is very good at the retail level and demand was good at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.

INDIANA: The weather for November has been warm overall with below average rainfall. Beekeepers report their bees in good condition. The bees should get one more cleansing flight before the cold weather settles in. Beekeepers have treated for mites. No foliage remains. The bees are ready for winter. Demand for honey is pretty good at the retail level and only fair at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.

IOWA, KANSAS, MISSOURI, NEBRASKA: No report issued.

KENTUCKY: Due to unseasonably chilly temperatures in October, most Kentucky hives had gone into winter cluster by November. Many hives may not have as much honey as needed to get the hives through the winter, so bee associations and the Beelines newsletter have been stressing the importance of supplemental feed. Beekeepers have also started winter varroa mite treatment of hives since that remains an effective time to rid hives of varroa mites, which also vector viruses. Some of the 2022 USDA Honey Bee Health Survey results indicate that nosema is present in about 1/3 of the apiaries, so at the combined Fall meeting for the Kentucky State Beekeepers Association and the Kentucky Queen Bee Breeders Association, it was specifically spoken about regarding the 2022 results and also included information about the nosema lab at Kentucky State University.

LOUISIANA: No report issued.

MICHIGAN: No report issued.

MINNESOTA: During the month of November temperatures were well below normal across the entire state. Precipitation for November was about normal for the northern part of the state. The southern part was slightly below normal.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in November the northern part of the state had normal soil moisture. The central part of the state had abnormally dry soil conditions. The southern part of the state had moderate to an area of extreme drought conditions.

Prices per pound in Minnesota were \$2.80-\$3.75 with mostly price of \$2.80-\$3.00 for locally sourced honey for the month of November.

MISSISSIPPI: Temperatures have been milder than usual and beekeepers haven't had to put in extra food yet to feed the bees. Weights and condition are reported to be good, and hives are ready and prepared for the winter months coming ahead. Sales have been moderate, and prices are a little higher. Price reported: Wildflower \$2.70 lb

MONTANA: No report issued.

NEW ENGLAND: No report issued.

NEW YORK: Dry conditions persist in the lower Hudson Valley and Long Island, which may impact Spring 2023 blooms. Continuing reports of fall hive loss is most likely from Varroa mite and virus. Beekeepers using the broodless period to treat for varroa are hopeful for the newly accepted Oxalic Extended Release method in New York State. Honey sales continue strong with good pricing.

NORTH CAROLINA: No report issued.

NORTH & SOUTH DAKOTA: Topsoil and subsoil moisture, very to adequate, mostly short all around, improved slightly with some precipitation later in the month. Harvest was nearly completed on corn and sunflowers, generally well ahead of last season and the 5-year average. Bees were moved to their winter homes as growers continued preparations for winter weather.

OHIO: November rain fall was below average, 70% of Ohio is abnormally dry, 54% is moderate dry, 10% is in severe drought. Depending on the location in Ohio, beekeepers were feeding honeybee colonies. Varroa mites are high in colonies that were developed from packages or Nucs from California or the southern states. Many of those beekeepers are new hobby beekeepers that did not treat the bees to kill varroa. Some beekeepers have low varroa mite populations with little or no mite treatments. Honey prices remain stable at \$5.50 - \$6.50 per pound wholesale and \$9.00 - \$11.00 retail.

OKLAHOMA: During the month of November temperatures were well below normal across most of the state. Precipitation was about normal. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, the state had mostly extreme drought conditions with areas of exceptional drought scattered across the state. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey

OREGON: No report issued.

SOUTH CAROLINA: No report issued.

TENNESSEE: Tennessee has not had sources of nectar or pollen for the month of November due to cooler than normal temperatures. Beekeepers are expecting to have to start feeding the hives in the next month or so. The only supply chain issues that are being reported are the availability of honey containers.

TEXAS: During the month of November temperatures were well below normal across the state. Precipitation during was well above normal across most of the state for a very much needed relief. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, soil moisture conditions showed soil moisture conditions overall better across the state. There were a few small areas of normal soil moisture scattered across the state. There was an area of extreme to exceptional drought conditions in the San Antonio area and some small areas extreme drought scattered across the state. Most of the state received enough rain to get back to moderate soil moisture.

Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

WASHINGTON: Early in the month heavy rains fell in the Western part of the state with heavy snows in the mountains. As colder weather moved into the Central part of the state vegetable harvest ended and growers worked to bring in the last Fuji and Cripps Pink apples. The wet weather continued with rain and snow throughout the state depending on temperatures. With the onset of much colder temperatures in the center of the state the apple harvest came to a close. Wintery weather continued through the month with periods of rain and snow and generally cold conditions.

WISCONSIN: The weather has been good for November with warmer than average temperatures and with a greater than average rainfall. The bees had a few cleansing flights before the cold weather settled in. Beekeepers have prepared for the winter. Beekeepers report that there is no more wild foliage for their bees. Most have finished treatment for mites. Some beekeepers have finished feeding their bees, while a few others continue to feed them. Most beekeepers report that their bees are in good condition. Demand for honey is good at the retail level and fairly good at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.
