## COLONY, HONEY PLANT AND MARKET CONDITIONS DURING DECEMBER 2022

APPALACHIAN DISTRICT (MD, PA, VA, WV): December's weather was about normal for the start of the month, however, by Christmas the area was in a deep freeze with nearly record setting cold high and low temperatures. Precipitation was about average. Beekeepers were very busy checking on colonies and keeping food supplied; however, despite their efforts and the colonies doing well going prior to the cold spell, several beekeepers reported some colony losses as they came out of the bitter cold period. They are now activity looking to purchase replacement bees for spring arrival.

ALABAMA: December started off with above average temperatures and a moderate drought in northern parts of the state; plants like henbit and dandelions were visited by bees. By the third week of December, bitter cold temperatures arrived, and southern portions of the state experienced drought-like conditions. These cold temperatures meant that bees were not departing from their colonies often, and there was little to no forage available. Most colonies likely possessed some capped brood throughout the month of December, especially given that cold temperatures came during the latter half of the month. Anticipating low brood, some beekeepers treated with oxalic acid. Beekeepers also regularly checked their food stores, especially in anticipation of the forecasted cold weather at the end of December.

ARIZONA: No report issued

ARKANSAS: During the month of December temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was about normal across most of the same area. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, northern Arkansas had abnormally dry moderate drought with an area of normal soil moisture in the northwest corner of the state. Southern Arkansas was abnormally dry to moderate drought conditions. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

CALIFORNIA: "December was harsh on the bees," a California beekeeper said, citing heavy rains and cool weather that limited flight time for colonies. "The rain will help a lot in the coming months as drought conditions disappear," he said. "We had about 14 inches of rain in our area, and the sage producing areas received a lot of rain in the last two weeks. We have been feeding syrup when we are able to access the colonies." Weather was too cool to encourage much plant growth, but as days get longer and warmer there could be good forage ahead, he added.

"We haven't followed the honey markets lately as we have no honey to sell," he said. "This should change by June with the anticipated sage crop from all of this rain."

Another beekeeper said December rains laid the groundwork for a good honey crop in 2023. A few ground flowers were already starting to provide pollen late in the month.

As far as almond pollination, some beekeepers had already begun to contact growers to assess their needs for pollination in early to mid-February. "I suspect that there may be a shortage of bees this year due to Florida's hurricane effect on the bees there and some reports that many colonies have died from out-of-state beekeepers due the drought conditions of poor forage," a beekeeper said. "Almond pollination should be OK as long as it doesn't keep raining through February, although we will take all the rain we can get!" a beekeeper said. "Much of California is still technically in drought in spite of the abundant rain we have received recently."

FLORIDA: The month enjoyed about normal temperatures until just before Christmas when temperatures plunged below freezing in most areas from Central Florida northward. There were several nights with lows around 26-28 depending upon how far north of Orlando you were located. Freezing or near freezing night-time temperatures extended further south in the state. Highs for several days were in the 40's in Central and North Florida. Most vegetation except for cold weather crops like cabbage and greens were destroyed. Temperatures had warmed back up to around 80 by New Year's Day weekend. Precipitation was about normal for the month.

Bee health was about average with heavy supplemental feeding needed for part of the month. There were scattered amounts of Spanish Needle available in some areas, but not many other alternatives. It should be mid to late January before maple, orange and Titi begin to bloom, depending upon weather conditions. Later in January is also when Florida bees are expected to begin pollinating blueberries in Florida and Georgia.

The Florida State Beekeepers Association released a report showing an estimate of 150-300 thousand hives destroyed by Hurricane Ian. These losses combined with average annual winter losses of around 25% means that Florida faces a potential loss of around 40% of their hives. Demand for almond pollination in California is expected to be a little less this year. Some beekeepers will elect to voluntarily skip California and rebuild their hive numbers for Florida honey production next spring. Due to the lack of honey produced during the month, beekeepers may have received slightly higher prices for any previously stored honey which was mostly Brazilian Pepper. There was practically no stored honey available at the end of the month.

GEORGIA: The beekeepers are busy making sure that the bees are safe and staying fed during an interesting month. Some cold nights and mornings but nothing lasting too long. Rain has been keeping the bees in the hives but not for long. The bees are reported to be in good shape and the condition of their weight is holding well for winter. Beekeepers are preparing for next month and producing nucs and splitting hives for sale. Prices remain steady.

IDAHO, COLORADO, UTAH: During the month of December temperatures were a little below normal across Idaho, Utah, and Colorado. Precipitation was above average for Idaho, Utah, and Colorado.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in December Idaho had very little relief from the dry situation. It had moderate drought to an area of severe drought along the southern border. Utah is currently under severe to extreme drought conditions with most of the state under extremely dry soil conditions. Colorado has an area of normal soil moisture through the center of the state with areas of moderate to severe drought in the eastern and western portions of the state.

Prices for the month of December were between \$2.60 and \$3.20 per pound with a mostly price of \$2.80-\$3.00 for Idaho, Colorado prices are too few producers reporting to determine a market. Prices for locally sourced honey in Utah are \$2.80-\$3.00 per pound with mostly \$2.80.

ILLINOIS: Illinois has had slightly colder than average weather with very little snow. A lot of precipitation fell, but most of it came as rain. Some Beekeepers have reported losing many colonies. Many have Beekeepers are going to meetings, checking, and repairing equipment and preparing to order packages. Demand for honey is very good at the retail level and good at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.

INDIANA: The weather for December was a bit colder than normal at the end of the month with very little precipitation. Some Beekeepers report that they have lost some hives. Beekeepers stopped supplemental feeding of their bees. Beekeepers are going to meetings and checking and repairing equipment. Demand for honey is good at the retail level and demand was fairly good at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.

IOWA, KANSAS, MISSOURI, NEBRASKA: No report issued.

KENTUCKY: Kentucky beekeepers have had a front-row seat to a turbulent year of ice storms, historic floods, and earlier-than-normal snow. As if to punctuate this year's patterns, the month of December was notable for its record-cold during Christmas, and then within a week, a shift to record-warmth before the year ended. While beekeepers took advantage of the 70-degree F temperatures to treat for varroa mites with oxalic acid, they also reported some hive losses. Most beekeepers attributed the losses to the severe and sustained cold weather that arrived on Dec. 22 and did not relent until Dec. 28. As the year ended, the results from USDA Honey Bee Health Survey samples indicate that varroa mites and viruses were present in the apiaries. However, compared to 2021 results, nosema spores were very low in the apiaries that were sampled. Even though some beekeepers lost hives, just as many beekeepers reported that their hives had good populations and attribute their hives' health to providing ventilation, building windbreaks, and keeping varroa mite populations low.

LOUISIANA: No report issued.

MICHIGAN: No report issued.

MINNESOTA: During the month of December temperatures were well below normal across the entire state. Precipitation was far above normal for the northern part of the state. The southern part was slightly above normal.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in December the northern part of the state had normal soil moisture. The central part of the state had abnormally dry soil conditions. The southern part of the state had moderate to an area of severe drought conditions.

Prices per pound in Minnesota were \$2.80-\$3.75 with mostly price of \$2.80-\$3.00 for locally sourced honey for the month of December.

MISSISSIPPI: The bees have been in and out of the hives during the cold weather and staying in with a lot of rain this month. They are reported to be in good condition heading into January and beekeepers are hoping for strong demand and sales of Queens and Nucs. Some supplemental feeding may be used to keep the bees in good heavy weight for the later cold months coming ahead.

MONTANA: No report issued.

NEW ENGLAND: No report issued.

NEW YORK: The end of the month brought extreme cold and windchill, winnowing out weak or small colonies. Locations northeast of Lakes Erie and Ontario received heavy snow. Wayne, Monroe, Ontario counties, the lower Hudson Valley, and Long Island continue to be abnormally dry. There has been strong varroa mite pressure in many parts of New York State, with higher than normal colony loss this Fall. Many beekeepers are ordering replacement bees for the Spring and cleaning out equipment in preparation. Some late season bear activity noted. Honey supply good; Holiday honey sales reported to be strong.

NORTH CAROLINA: No report issued.

NORTH & SOUTH DAKOTA: No report issued.

OHIO: Ohio honeybees colonies experienced radical swings in temperatures and rain amounts during December. Most of Ohio received low amounts of rain, western Ohio was in a mild drought while eastern Ohio received below normal amounts, which has been ongoing for many weeks. Temperature range was a high of 65 degrees to a low of 9 degrees below 0. Varroa mite levels were very high if beekeepers didn't perform some type of mite control. Less experienced beekeepers are struggling to keep their colonies alive. Locally Adapted Ohio honeybees have low mite counts at this time. Honey prices remain stable: Wholesale \$5.50 - \$6.50, Retail \$9.00- \$11.00.

OKLAHOMA: During the month of December temperatures were about normal across most of the state. Precipitation was about normal. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, the state had mostly severe to exceptional drought scattered across the state. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey

OREGON: No report issued.

SOUTH CAROLINA: No report issued.

TENNESSEE: December was cold and wet. No nectar or pollen sources were available during December, so beekeepers were feeding throughout the month. To date no losses have been reported during December, but this is expected to quickly change.

TEXAS: During the month of December temperatures were about normal across the state. Precipitation was well below normal across most of the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, soil moisture conditions for December showed soil moisture conditions starting to revert back to the drier conditions Texans have become accustomed to across the state. East Texas had mostly normal to areas of abnormally dry conditions. Central Texas had areas of normal soil moisture to moderate drought with an area of extreme drought to exceptional drought around the San Antonio area remaining from previous months. The panhandle area saw moderate drought to a few scattered areas of extreme drought. Far West Texas had normal to abnormally dry conditions.

A hard freeze across the state the week before Christmas made for some traveling issues but luckily nothing like our Northern neighbors encountered. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

WASHINGTON: No report issued.

WISCONSIN: December weather was slightly colder than usual with lots of precipitation. Some beekeepers used an oxalic fogger to treat remaining hives. Many beekeepers show few hives remain and are supplementing their feed. Beekeeping associations are meetings this month. Beekeepers are checking and repairing their equipment, taking unused boxes and frames, scraping them down and stacking them for use in the Spring. Demand for honey is good at the retail level and fairly good at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.
