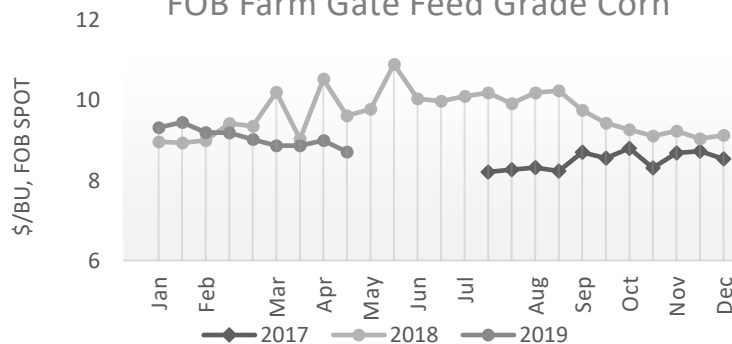
## Grain and Feedstuffs Market Trend

Compared to two weeks ago: Trade active on light to moderate demand for feed grade corn with the bulk of activity on forward contracting. Corn traded 29 cents lower. Feed grade soybean trade and demand moderate with the bulk of activity on the spot market with no comparable trades from the prior report to trend. Trade activity too limited on wheat to report. Trade inactive on all other organic grains. The next available report will be Wednesday, May 22, 2019.

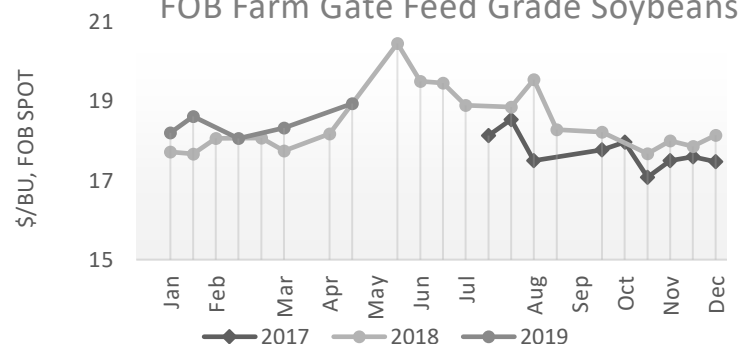

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### Current Midwest Drought Summary (April 30, 2019)

For the tenth consecutive week, the Midwest remained free of dryness and drought. Enough drying took place for corn planting to be 45% complete by April 28 in Missouri, a sharp increase from 16% the previous week. Similarly, corn planting in Iowa was 21% complete on that date, up from 4% on April 21. Still, those values were behind the respective 5-year averages of 55 and 26% in Missouri and Iowa.
