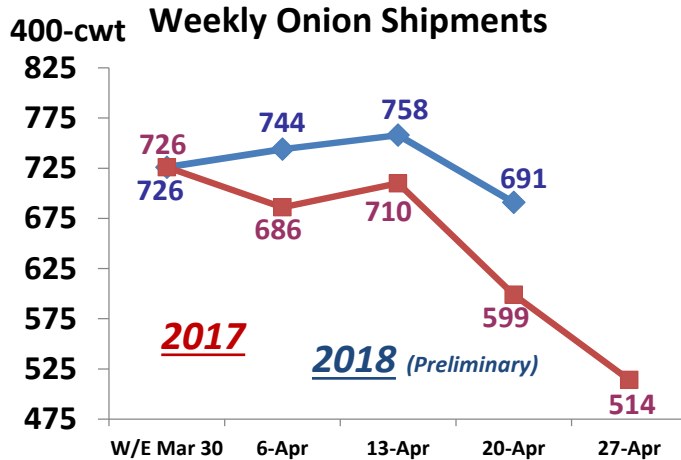

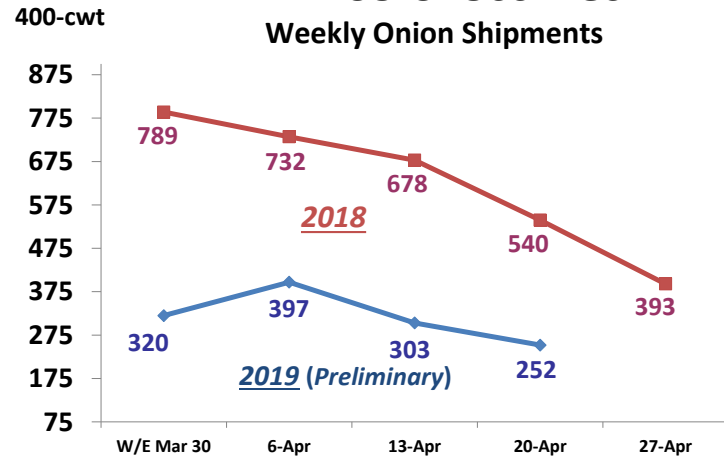
### LOWER RIO GRANDE VALLEY, TEXAS Weekly Onion Shipments



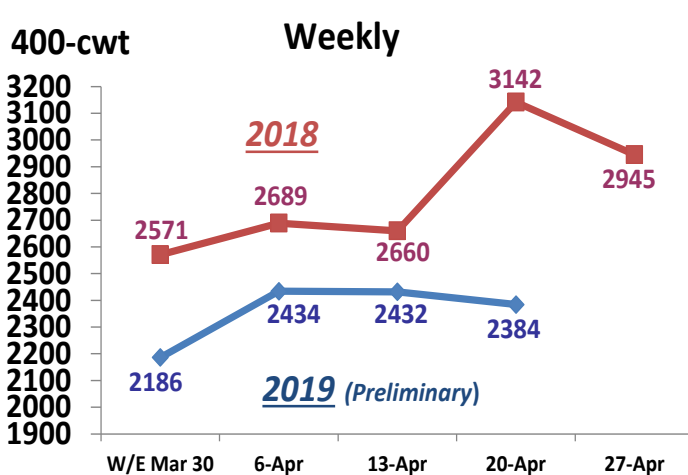

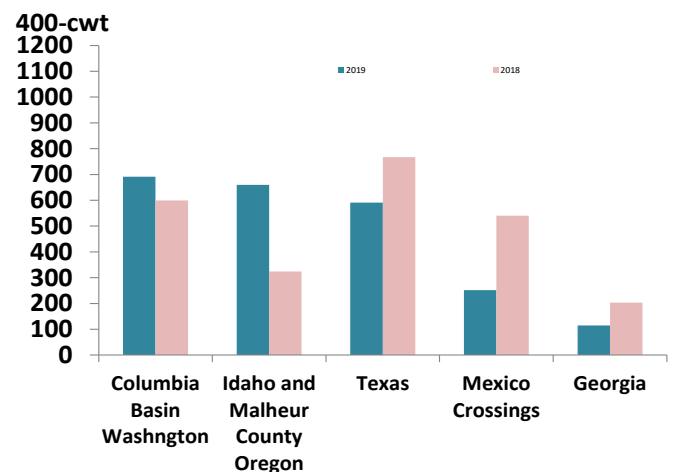

These stocks represent 16% of the total production, stored by both processors and growers for fresh, seed and processing usage. (\* revised)

**WISCONSIN** Shipments 98-117-130 --- Movement expected to remain about the same. Too few open market sales to establish a market.

**AROOSTOOK COUNTY MAINE** Shipments 68-48\*-93 --- Movement expected to decrease. Most movement on pre-season contract. Too few open market sales to establish a market. According to the April 1, 2019 Potato Stocks released by NASS, Maine's holdings of 5.2 million cwt. were up nearly 4% from one year earlier (5.0 million cwt. These stocks represent 34% of total production and include potatoes for fresh, seed and processing usage. (\* revised)
