Compared to last week, all reported hay sales sold steady. Demand was moderate to good. Some farmers are out baling cornstalks, as the extra "trash" needs to come off for better seed to soil placement. These new crop, late baled stalks are trading in the 80.00 to 85.00 range and will be ground into a feedlot ration. Some areas of the state had blizzard conditions this week with other areas continuing to look forward to some type of moisture. Brutal winds across most areas continues to take moisture out of the topsoil. US drought monitor as of Thursday, April 6, 2023 continues to show most of the state in a severe drought with several areas extreme or worse! Hopefully the April showers will come along so the May flowers will bloom.
