Compared to last week, dairy steers were not tested. Feeder steers were not well tested. Trade slow, demand light. Supply consisted of a few feeder steers weighing 800 lbs for current FOB delivery. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 100%. Unless otherwise stated, prices fob shipping point with 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent with 5-10 cent slide on calves, 3-6 cent slide on yearlings from base weight. Delivered prices include freight, commissions and other expenses. Livestock reported this week originated from CA.
