Compared to the last report: Hay trade is slow with moderate demand. The western part of Oklahoma did receive much-needed moisture. New crop hay has been put on hold due to the rain across Oklahoma. The pricing of hay is still undetermined because of the unknown number of bales that need to be cut to determine the cost of harvest. The Oklahoma Mesonet Drought Monitor shows we are at 20.62 percent in exceptional drought, 43.19 percent in an extreme drought, 49.87 percent in severe drought, 54.07 percent in moderate, 64.52 percent in abnormally dry conditions, 35.48 percent that has no drought conditions.
