



My Market News (MMN) home page.


Select Login and follow the prompts to create an **eAuthentication** if you don't already have one.



An example of **general Cotton landing page (left)** and **Logged in as a Registered User (right)**


On the left, if not a **Registered User**. You still have access to all the reports and data, as a **Registered User** you can save database queries, subscribe, and add as a favorite various reports.

The advantage of a **Registered User** is having your own personalized MMN landing page. Tailored to house the reports you like to see often.




Once you are logged in, use the dropdown under your name and click on **My Profile**. **My Profile** takes you to your personalized home page.

You may begin to subscribe and add to favorites. Plus you can save your database queries to your home page.




To subscribe or add to favorites, you can do both.


You **must** be on the individual report landing page and the options to subscribe & add to favorites is available on the bottom of the screen.



To save a data search, complete the data query in **Search Market News Database** through the My Market News home page. In this example, this is the Corpus Christi quality report. Once you **Get Data**, you can **Save Search Condition**.



Once you select **Save Search Condition**, the portal will ask you to name your search. After you name it, click save. The report will go to your **profile** under **User saved queries**.



The newest query is now saved in My Profile.
